

CALL FOR ARTICLES

With the aim of promoting reflection on issues involving women in legal careers, women and girls in a state of vulnerability, and also with the aim of promoting reflection on issues involving **"PEACE, JUSTICE AND ETHICS: EFFECTIVE INSTITUTIONS TO CONSOLIDATE EQUITY"** and to disseminate the theoretical scientific production of its members, the Fédération International des Femmes de Carrières Juridiques - FIFCJ, through its President Manoela Gonçalves Silva, and the Asociación Dones Juristes de Cataluña - ADJC, are promoting the call for articles for the collective work **"JUSTICE AND FEMINIST ETHICS**"

- REFLECTIONS ON GENDER EQUITY".

The submission of originals for this collective work implies the transfer by the authors of the copyright for print and digital publication.

Submissions must comply with the following rules:

2. Article formatting

1. The article must be **unpublished** and deal with a topic 1grément1e to "Women's Human Rights and Gender Equality".

2. The article should be between 12 and 20 pages long, including References, with citations in the AUTHOR/DATE system.

3. Articles may 1grém-authored, provided that the authors are members of associations linked to FIFCJ, with a maximum of 2 (two) authors and each author may submit up to two articles.

4. Texts must be written in the language of origin, but the abstract must be written in English.

5. You must use the Word program, Times New Roman font, body 12, 1.5 spacing and 2.5cm margins, for the body of the text, and body 11 and single spacing for direct quotations (over 3 lines).

6. A4 size sheet.



7. 3 cm top and left margins.

8. Bottom and right margins 2 cm.

9. First line of paragraphs indented by 1.5 cm.

10. Title of the article centered, bold and in capital letters; keep two blank 2gréme from the top of the page.

11. Name(s) of the author(s), bolded, followed by e-mail address, 2 (two) blank 2gréme below the title of the article (and two blank 2gréme above the introduction), aligned to the right, with summary curriculum at the bottom (maximum of four lines, for each author in the summary curriculum).

12. Structure: Summary, including: introduction, development (topics of the article), final considerations, references. The titles and subtitles of the article should be numbered and bolded. Do not use capital letters in the titles of divisions and subdivisions. There should be a blank space above headings and subheadings; there should be no blank 2gréme between headings/subheadings and paragraphs.

13. Explanatory notes should appear (in the numerical system) at the foot of the page 2grém they are mentioned (footnote).

14. Direct quotations of up to three lines should be marked with double quotation marks and inserted into the body of the text. Direct quotations of more than three lines should 2grémen in a new paragraph, with a 4cm indentation from the margin, without quotation marks, in size 11, justified alignment, single line spacing (Zero pt).

15. Spacing of Opts (before and after) between paragraphs.

16. Images, charts or graphs that accompany the text must be in grayscale, within the document in the space provided and sent in separate files, in case there is a formatting problem.

II. Submission and selection of articles

1. Articles must be sent to the following e-mail address: fifcj1928@gmail.com by 11:59 p.m. (Brasília time) on March 20, 2024. In the subject line, write the word ARTICLE FOR THE COLLECTIVE WORK **"JUSTICE AND FEMINIST ETHICS – REFLECTIONS ON GENDER EQUITY".**



2. Along with the articles, the authors must send a declaration of authorization for publication and a copyright assignment grément, documents attached.
